

Temporary Concession Stands

Volleyball/Basketball/Football/Baseball/Softball/Auditorium
(This applies to all temporary concessions set-up anywhere on/in
district #741 grounds/buildings)

These facilities have electrical power, but no running water.

Eligible items to serve without a MN Department of Health Concession License:

Canned/bottled beverages,

Coffee,

Hot Chocolate made using individual hot chocolate packets,

Doughnuts, rolls – individually packaged,

Packaged candy

Packaged chips/crackers/pretzels

Packaged nuts/seeds (sunflower seeds)

Microwave popcorn prepared in NSF and UL approved microwave oven and served in the package,

Nachos – individual chip bags and individual serving cheese containers (warmed in microwave).

If you or your group choose to offer a wider selection of food/beverage choices than are eligible above, you or your group must obtain your own concession license through the Minnesota Department of Health (<http://www.health.state.mn.us>; phone: 612.201.4500) and a copy of said license must be on file in the Paynesville Area Community Education Office prior to the first date of your event.
